Role Title; Football Development Officer (FDO)

Description; The FDO will oversee all clubs onfield activities and be the first point of contact for coaches with concerns or issues relating to coaching itself, and work with the clubs core committee to develop and support the clubs strategic development plan.

- Act as the initial point of contact to newly appointed coaches, promoting the clubs mentor scheme, and allocating them a club mentor
- Review the clubs Academy (U5/6s) and Waiting List to consider (in line with the clubs development plan) opportunities to generate new teams across all age groups
- Build a cohesive approachable environment for coaches to work together as one large team, including sharing of session plans, coach forums, FAQs
- Support the overall club development strategy and ethos
